This full-time position combines two interrelated roles: a Montessori Guide for students ages 6-12 and a Spanish Immersion Teacher for Preschool through 8th grade. The ideal candidate is a fluent Spanish speaker and Montessori-trained educator who is passionate about fostering independent learning and bilingualism through immersive, developmentally appropriate instruction. The educator will divide their time equally between guiding a Montessori classroom and delivering Spanish- only immersion education-with a strong focus on Spanish pre-literacy and literacy skills.

Training in Spanish literacy instruction (e.g., syllabic and phonetic progression, dictados, comprehension strategies).

Knowledge of second-language acquisition theory and practices such as Comprehensible Input, TPR, or dual-language models.

Background in culturally inclusive and anti-bias teaching.

Montessori Guide (50%)

- Prepare and maintain a carefully curated Montessori environment that supports student autonomy, concentration, and intrinsic motivation.
- Present Montessori lessons aligned with students' developmental needs, using hands-on materials in small and individual groups.
- Observe and assess student learning regularly, using these observations to adjust instruction and guide academic and social development.
- Foster responsibility, self-regulation, and peaceful conflict resolution.
- Maintain accurate records of student progress and collaborate with team members to ensure consistent, individualized support.

Spanish Immersion Teacher (50%)

- Deliver immersive Spanish instruction to Preschool through 8th grade using an exclusively Spanish-speaking approach- no English is used during instruction or classroom communication.
- Plan and implement a comprehensive language program that develops listening, speaking preliteracy and literacy in Spanish.
- In early childhood, emphasize Spanish pre-literacy skills such as phonemic awareness, vocabulary building, sound-symbol relationships, and oral language development through storytelling, songs, and interactive play.

- In elementary and middle school grades, lead instructions in Spanish reading fluency, comprehension, spelling, grammar, and writing composition at developmentally appropriate levels.
- Use visual aids, movement, music, realia, and thematic units to support language acquisition and engagement across all grades.
- Embed Hispanic, Latin American, and Spanish culture into lessons and seasonal activities to deepen cultural understanding.
- Monitor student progress in all language domains and provide feedback in Spanish in a supportive, growth-oriented environment.
- Participate in faculty meetings, parent communication, and school-wide cultural and community
 events
- Engage in ongoing professional development related to both Montessori and language immersion best practices.
- Support cross-curricular connections between Spanish and classroom content when appropriate.
- Collaborate with assistants, faculty, and administration to ensure program alignment and continuity.
